An innovative, customized capacity building methodology complementing the standard classroom routine immunization training. Its aptitudes include Leveraging technology dissemination amongst the healthcare workers



RISE Scale up-1, 2021-2022











About 12,500+ learners in 36 districts have been accessing and completing the course





- On an average 10 points increase in knowledge levels is observed among the learners
- Highest knowledge gain (14 points) is observed in Module 2, followed by Module 3 (12 points)

Data Collection Activities in the field for the Outcome Evaluation

A comprehensive outcome evaluation for the RISE Scale up-1 is carried out by an independent evaluation agency. The data collection begun from first week of Sep 2022 and gradually covered all the sampled blocks, districts from the three states. A total of 10 districts with 30 blocks have been sampled where Knowledge and Practice Assessment for the quantitative and In-depth interviews with various stakeholders for the qualitative data were carried out.



Activities in the Field for RISE Scale up-2

A total of 16 districts from Madhya Pradesh have been included in the RISE Scale up-2. Three districts have completed the district ToT and block level training successfully. A total of 1424 learners have been oriented with the RISE training. RISE training is go-live in Agar Malwa, Betul and Hoshangabad (Narmadapuram) districts.







Likewise, 10 districts from Odisha have been included in the RISE Scale up-2 and on 9th Sep, 2022, Odisha State ToT for the RISE Scale up-2 was organised. The event was carried out virtually at the Directorate of Family Welfare conference hall, Bhubaneswar and DIOs from all the 10 districts participated along with the Project Director (Dr PS Ganguly), RISE Project and JSI RISE Team.
