



RAPID IMMUNIZATION SKILL ENHANCEMENT

RISE is an innovative, learner-centric, e-learning platform (mobile/web app) designed to build the capacity of healthcare workers involved in routine immunization in India. Conceptualised and developed by JSI under the guidance of the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoHFW), it leverages digital technology to complement traditional classroom training by offering a self-paced learning experience, thus revolutionizing how healthcare workers are trained. Designed to enhance knowledge and skills, it also keeps the health care workers updated on the evolving Universal Immunization Programme (UIP) guidelines. With its scalable design and user-friendly interface, the aim is to ultimately improve immunization outcomes across the country.

RISE MODULES

The RISE platform consists of 5 specialized modules, each developed based on the insights from a comprehensive Capacity Building Needs Assessment. This assessment meticulously analyzed the training needs of vaccinators at the field level, ensuring the content is tailored to meet their specific challenges and requirements of vaccinators.

Each module includes a pre-test and post-test, where learners must achieve a minimum score of 70% to generate a certificate for that module. Upon completing all five modules, the learner will be awarded a Master Certificate.




PROGRESS AT A GLANCE

Among the **1,50,194** learners in 324 Go LIVE districts on the platform, **98%** of learners have **started the first module**, and **94%** have **completed all modules**. Figure A illustrates the module-wise percentage progress of learners.


Overall knowledge gain is calculated based on the difference between the pre and post-test scores of learners who have completed all five modules.

The maximum knowledge gain is observed in the second module, focused on injection safety and vaccine administration, with more than 50% of learners achieving a score improvement of more than 20 percentage points.


Learners can earn two types of certificates based on their performance:




Module Wise Progress Status (till December 2025)




Pre and Post Test Scores of Learners (%)

Key Activities across RISE Intervention States

ARUNACHAL PRADESH



During field visits in Upper Siang, Lower Siang, and Dibang Valley districts, vaccinators received on-site handholding support on using the RISE application, including offline access to modules and referrals, as well as new features such as resource download, mobile number update, and password change.

The State issued formal letter to all 26 District Medical Officers to identify the newly recruited vaccinators and enroll them in RISE platform.

87.6% RI Mentors successfully completed all five RISE modules, and the state has achieved a 95.9% completion rate for Module 5

RAJASTHAN



New learners enrolled from Ajmer, Balotra, Barmer, Ganganagar, Hanumangarh, Jaisalmer, Jalore, Nagaur, Phalodi, Sikar, Sirohi, and Udaipur.

Field visits along with hands-on support provided to learners across fifteen districts including Ajmer, Balotra, Banswara, Barmer, Beawer, Dungarpur, Ganganagar, Hanumangarh, Jalore, Jodhpur, Kota, Pali, Phalodi, Sirohi, and Udaipur.

At state level, 97.4% of learners have completed Module 5.

Key Activities across RISE Intervention States

UTTAR PRADESH



For the RI Supervisors, Module 1 initiation rate is 85% and completion rate is 57% (Module was Go Live on 3rd October 2025)

Supportive supervision visits were conducted across 38 blocks and 22 districts to provide reorientation and handholding to supervisors and learners.

Meetings were conducted in four districts (Etah, Agra, Etawah, and Banda) under the chairpersonship of the CMO, with participation from the DIO, ACOMO-RCH, MOICs, and development partners. The progress of RISE was reviewed and the block-wise RI Supervisor pendency sheet was shared. CMO assured RISE module would be completed by the RI supervisors, while the DIO emphasized their importance in strengthening supportive supervision; all MOICs assured timely completion.

The Module 5 completion rate of vaccinator is 99.3%.

"I have received RISE training at the state level. During our field visits, it became clear that even though vaccination workers put in 100% effort, small errors pose challenges to full coverage. Our team is dedicated, but some issues remained in communication, session planning, community engagement and proper handling of the vaccine, impacting the success of the campaign.

Sometime back, Block and District level front-line workers (ANM, LHV, CHO, SN) were trained through 5 modules of RISE. In the training, detailed information was given on vaccine management, injection safety, AEFI management, and communication and strategy formulation with families hesitant in vaccination.

After completing the RISE module, there has been a significant improvement in the skills of the vaccinator as well as the supervisor (RI Supervisor). This has enhanced the planning, session coverage, data quality and community participation of Tika Utsav, Pulse Polio and Td campaigns.

Not only the vaccinators, but the field supervisors have also been empowered, our supervisors and vaccinators can solve the problems arising during vaccination in a better way. If any beneficiary comes with any problem after vaccination, then how to report it to the health worker is also learned in a better way through RISE module, which has further strengthened the vaccination services in the district.

I thank the State, Centre, and especially the entire JSI team who supported our district through the RISE training."
