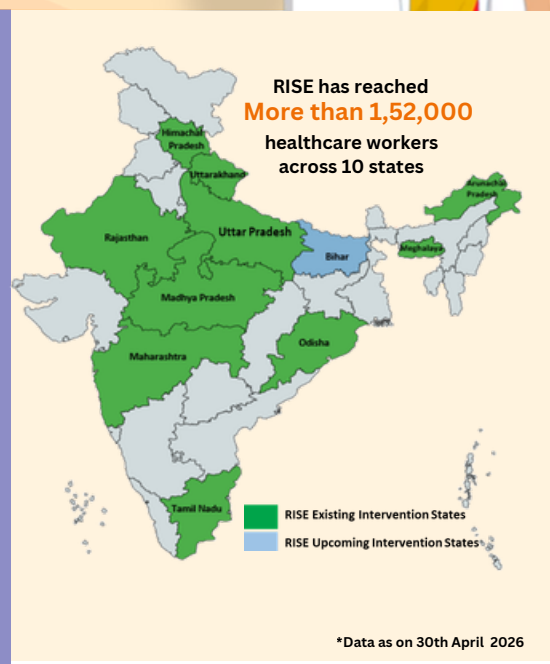
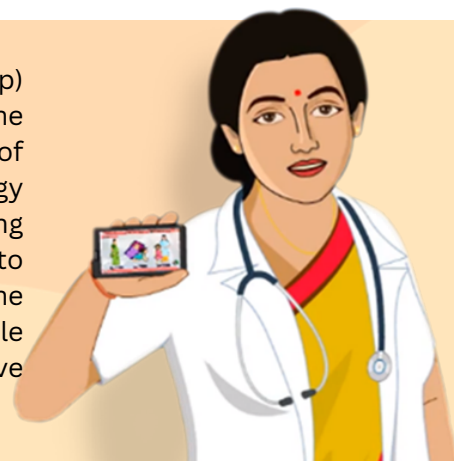


# RAPID IMMUNIZATION SKILL ENHANCEMENT

*Innovate | Improvise | Immunize*



RISE is an innovative, learner-centric, e-learning platform (mobile/web app) designed to build the capacity of healthcare workers involved in routine immunization in India. Conceptualised and developed by JSI under the guidance of the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoHFW), it leverages digital technology to complement traditional classroom training by offering a self-paced learning experience, thus revolutionizing how healthcare workers are trained. Designed to enhance knowledge and skills, it also keeps the health care workers updated on the evolving Universal Immunization Programme (UIP) guidelines. With its scalable design and user-friendly interface, the aim is to ultimately improve immunization outcomes across the country.



## RISE MODULES

The RISE platform consists of 5 specialized modules, each developed based on the insights from a comprehensive Capacity Building Needs Assessment. This assessment meticulously analyzed the training needs of vaccinators at the field level, ensuring the content is tailored to meet their specific challenges and requirements of vaccinators.

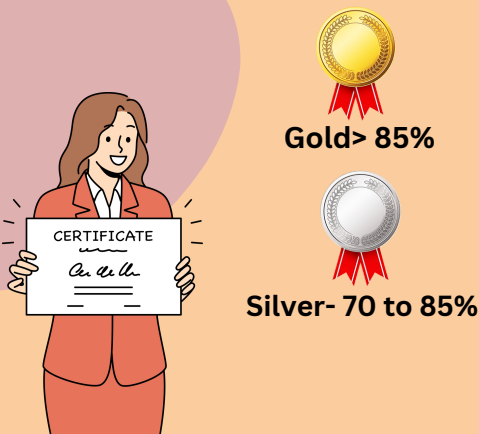
## PROGRESS AT A GLANCE

Among the **1,52,653** learners in 336 Go LIVE districts on the platform, **99%** of learners have **started the first module**, and **94.4%** have **completed all modules**. Figure A illustrates the module-wise percentage progress of learners.

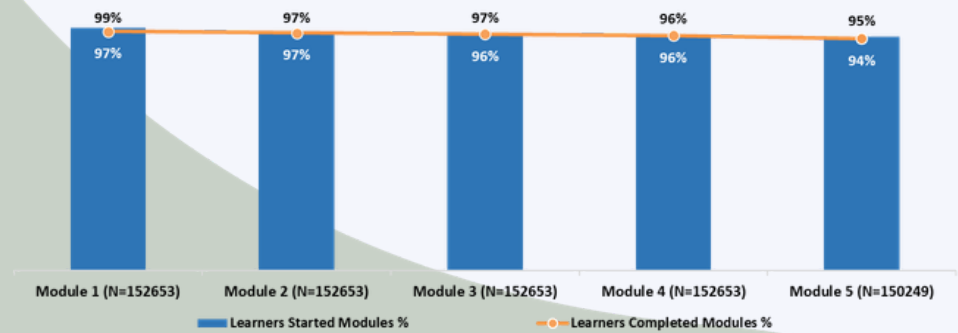
Overall knowledge gain is calculated based on the difference between the pre and post-test scores of learners who have completed all five modules.

The maximum knowledge gain is observed in the second module, focused on injection safety and vaccine administration, with more than 50% of learners achieving a score improvement of more than 20 percentage points.

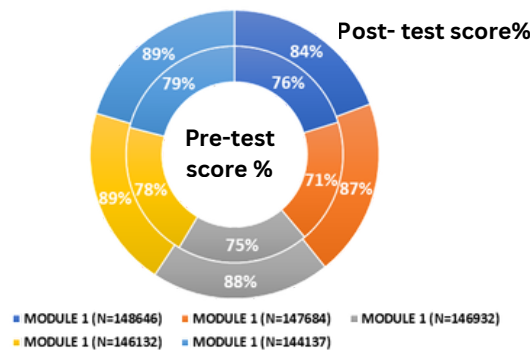

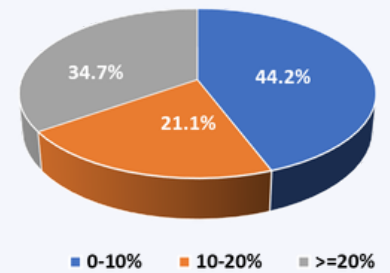
## Module Wise Progress Status (till April 2026)



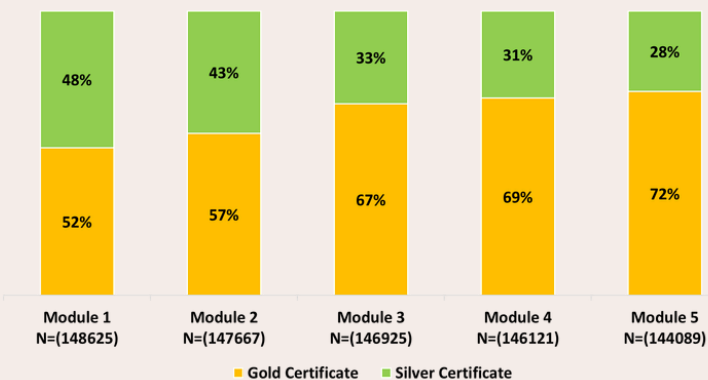
## Pre and Post Test Scores of Learners (%)

# Key Activities across RISE Intervention States

## ARUNACHAL PRADESH

Impact assessment visits conducted in Kamle and East Kameng district to assess knowledge improvement among RI staff post RISE training.

Field-level interaction conducted with learners at CHC Boasimla.

Orientation and training session conducted for EPI staff on RISE application usage at the TRIHMS Hospital Naharalagun.

Module 5 completion rate is 96.7 %.



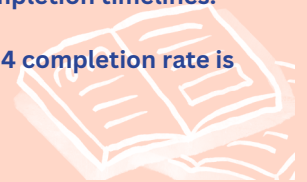
## MEGHALAYA

Monitoring and supportive supervision visits conducted in North Garo Hills and East Garo Hills.

Low-performing facilities with high pendency identified, and targeted re-orientation sessions conducted to enhance understanding of the RISE application, module navigation, and completion timelines.

Module 1 initiation rate is 99.9% and Module 4 completion rate is 96.8%.

Module 5 went Go Live on 27<sup>th</sup> April 2026



## MADHYA PRADESH

Targeted communications undertaken to track and motivate pending learners to complete their RISE modules.

After active follow up by project team in coordination with the State and district, significant improvements in module 5 completion rate observed across Alirajpur (19.2%), Guna (17.0%), Anuppur (16.9%), Seoni (14.7%), Barwani (14.5%), and Vidisha (13.7%) between 20 February and 30 April 2026.

Overall, 4.7% increase has been noted in the state module 5 completion rate from 82% in February 2026 to 86.7% in April 2026.

# Key Activities across RISE Intervention States

## UTTAR PRADESH

Review and supervisors' engagement meetings conducted across 29 blocks in 12 districts to review RI Supervisor Cadre and Vaccinator Cadre RISE module completion status and pendency tracking.

RI Supervisor and vaccinator RISE module progress reviewed during DHS meeting (Gautam Buddha Nagar) and DHS EC Meeting (Unnao).

Module 5 completion rate by vaccinators is 99.4 % and by RI supervisors is 81.8%.



## RAJASTHAN



RISE assessment carried out in Ajmer, Alwar and Balotra.

Convened meetings with key district officials, including RCHO, BCMO, DRCHO, and other stakeholders. Key activities included conducting KAP assessments (interviews, IDIs, FGDs), session site observations and coordination meetings with health officials

Pending learner follow-ups were conducted through district coordination. Block-wise progress updates were also shared with officials to strengthen monitoring and tracking.

State Module 5 completion rate of 99.2%.

## MAHARASHTRA

2-day orientation was conducted for the investigators in Pune on 13th and 14th April 2026 and post that the post-implementation data collection for RISE assessment is completed in the state.

KAP survey, session site observation, focus group discussions and In-depth interviews carried out as a part of Impact assessment in Nasik, Chandrapur and Chhatrapati Sambhajnagar.

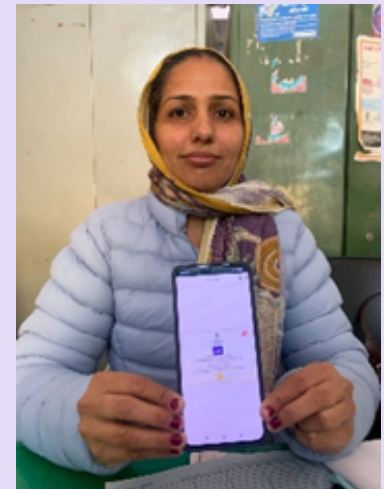
## What the RISE user has to say
